HWEUCSC kicked off and put the Hun team under pressure right from the start. We were playing some nice football and looked very comfortable and took a deserved lead on 10 minutes. Niall Hickey found himself 1 on 1 with the Huns goalkeeper but missed the opportunity to score himself after the goalkeeper parried his effort. The rebound fell invitingly for Liam Lapping to score and give the Hoops a deserved early lead.

The Hoops were always on top throughout the first half but were not making the most of the chances that were coming our way. Paul Henderson tried from long range, but his effort went narrowly over the bar. Michael Taggart had an effort that hit the crossbar. At times the Celtic midfield, mainly Paul Henderson, were guilty of over playing the ball at times when passes were on to teammates (although he’s adamant that nobody was moving for him!!).

Rangers started the 2nd Half strongly but we then grabbed a 2nd goal on 55mins, through Nick O’Neil. Nick picked up a through ball and buried his finish beyond the goalkeeper, who was screaming for offside. The 3rd followed as Scott Leask whipped in a corner,

which Seán Henderson met at the near post and headed beyond the keeper.

With 20 minutes to go, Niall Hickey went off to allow John Paul Mason to come on. His impact was instantaneous. Seán Henderson picked the ball up in midfield, and skipped past 2 players in the middle of the pitch and then released a sublime through ball with the outside of right boot. The Huns were screaming for offside, and they were right, Mikey Taggart was offside, however J.P. wasn’t. He ran through one on one with the keeper. J.P. tapped the ball to the side of the keeper but the keeper done his best to bring J.P. down. J.P. brushed the challenge aside to put the ball in the top corner to make it 4 nil to the Hoops. Cue wild celebrations (from J.P.).

The unflappable Maude picked a ball out of the air and proceeded to put it down for a goal kick, but the ball hadn’t gone out of play. Before he realised what had happened he put his hands back on the ball and referee was left with no option but to give an indirect free kick. You will know that, after Tommy's passing last year, we as a Club decided to have one Final Supper. This will be held on **Saturday 6th June 2009 at 7.00pm in the Banqueting Hall, Teviot Row House Students Union, Edinburgh University**. As always, we will have a night of haggis and neeps, whiskey and verse, and

speech and song. Our Guest of Honour will be Rosemary Burns, plus our Honorary President Pat Nevin, as well as others who have worn the Hoops, written about the Hoops, sung about the Hoops, or perhaps just happen to like them with the rest of us. This year's event will be a particularly special one, commemorating Tommy and celebrating 23 years of our event.

The TB Supper is a charitable event, normally solely for the HWEUCSC special cause Casa Alianza. However this year it has been decided that the

proceeds from the night will be halved, with half being donated to Casa and the other half donated to a charity of GOH Rosemary Burns' choice.

The full set of guests for this year's Supper has yet to be announced but our dedicated organising committee have been working tirelessly behind the scenes, in collaboration with Celtic, to provide some pleasant surprises. The work that has been ongoing and our correspondence with Celtic is a major reason for

the delay in the details of the Supper being finalised this year but we wanted to make sure that the Final Supper is one for all to remember.



We already have 25 willing volunteers for our squad, but would happily accept more. If you are interested, then contact Paul Henderson (contact details on page 2)

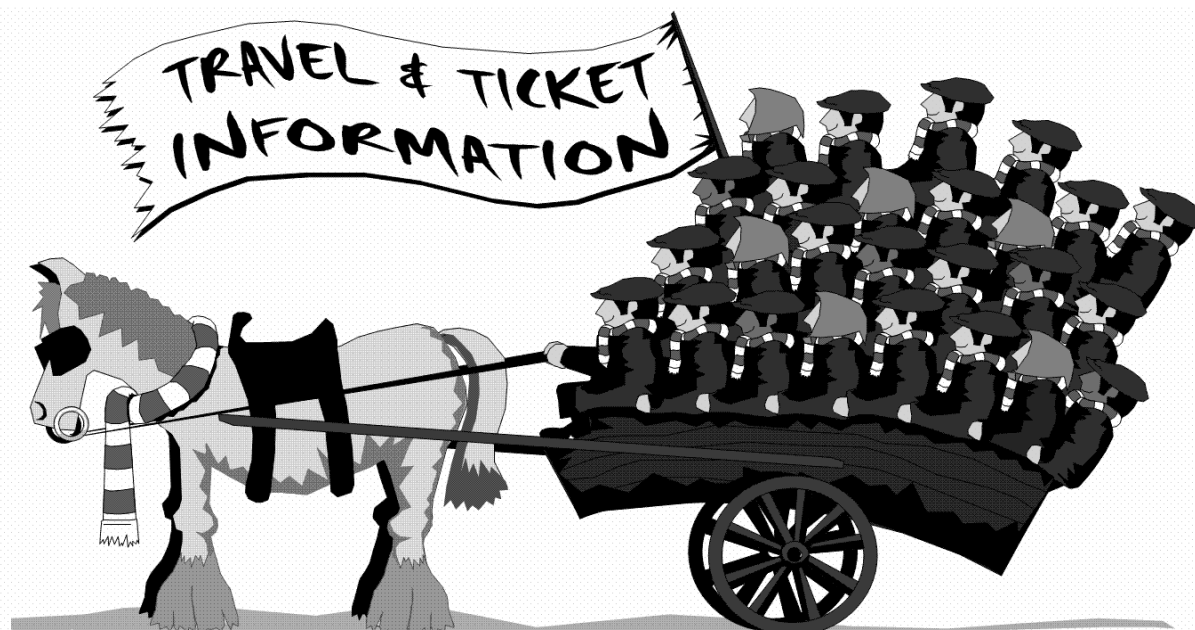
Points System Update
